Ignite Purpose

Our flagship programs, including high-level Executive Coaching, Transformational Learning, Transition Mentoring Workshops, and our proprietary program, Pursue Your Purpose, continued to guide veterans and their families through self-discovery and career exploration. These offerings empower Fellows to align their strengths and passions with meaningful careers and lives post-service.

Transition Mentoring Workshops: These two-day immersive experiences were held in 10 cities across the country, providing Fellows with tools to identify and pursue fulfilling goals and engage with leaders and mentors from various industries.

Pursue Your Purpose (PYP): This signature program helps Fellows work through self-exploration of strengths and values, life goals, and how to achieve them.









Redefine Identity

Tailored executive coaching sessions and mentoring workshops enabled our Fellows to embrace their unique strengths and redefine their identities beyond their military roles.

Transition Mentoring Workshops: Engaged over 160 Fellows in collaborative discussions and activities with industry leaders, focusing on professional growth and personal transformation.

Military Spouse Program: Recognizing the vital contributions of military spouses, this program supported over 100 individuals in rediscovering their aspirations and building new career paths.

In 2024, The COMMIT Foundation boldly expanded its reach and deepened its mission, creating new opportunities for those we serve and the communities that support them. We proudly opened our services to the Intelligence Community (all those defined by the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act) and the Five Eyes Community, as well as their spouses. This expansion allows us to serve an even broader network of high-potential individuals transitioning from some of the most complex and critical roles in national security. By recognizing the unique challenges faced by these individuals and their families, we are setting the stage for transformational support that honors their service and maximizes their postservice potential. In preparation for 2025 and beyond, we designed two groundbreaking programs that align with our commitment to innovation and impact. *On Purpose* is a program dedicated to helping individuals uncover and align with their unique sense of purpose as they experience transitions. Through guided reflection, coaching, and practical tools, participants will learn to navigate life pivots with clarity and confidence. Additionally, *Insights in Action* was developed to provide tailored opportunities for participants to engage in experiential learning, mentorship, and skill-building workshops that connect them directly to opportunities aligned with their goals.

Together, these programs reflect COMMIT's dedication to not just supporting transition but empowering true transformation. 2024 also saw a surge in partnerships and opportunities for our alumni Fellows and supporters. By increasing collaborations with organizations that share our vision, we expanded the resources and networks available to those we serve. New partnerships opened doors to leadership roles, mentorships, and impactful career pathways for our Fellows while fostering a stronger, more connected community of supporters. Beyond programmatic growth, we amplified our thought leadership last year, publishing new articles and blogs that sparked meaningful conversations around purpose, transition, and transformation. These pieces received national attention and underscored our position as a leader in the veteran and national security communities. News releases highlighting these initiatives further

strengthened COMMIT's reputation and visibility, ensuring our voice continues to inspire action and change. As we reflect on 2024, it's clear that it was a transformative year for The COMMIT Foundation. We are incredibly proud of the strides we've made and even more excited about the foundation we've laid for an impactful 2025. Together, with the continued support of our community, we are setting the conditions for the next chapter of growth, innovation, and service.















FROM Warrior To Entrepreneur

2024 TRANSFORMATION

After a distinguished military career as Commander of SEAL Team 5, Andrew S. (20 years as a Navy SEAL) faced the daunting challenge of transitioning into civilian life. Like many high-potential veterans, he initially pursued career paths aligned with societal expectations rather than personal fulfillment. Through thoughtful exploration, mentorship, and the right resources, he discovered a path that resonated with him and his family.

With the guidance of Director of Veteran Services, Meagan Thrift, Sparks engaged in deep self-reflection. He realized many of his options were driven by what he felt he "should do" rather than what he truly wanted. This insight led him toward entrepreneurship, focusing on acquiring or starting a business without external capital.



Around the same time, a conversation with a former SEAL teammate reignited a shared passion for building something impactful together. They explored opportunities and, after months of due diligence, aligned on **Gameday Men's Health Clinics**—a venture combining purpose, leadership, and ownership. After reviewing multiple franchises, ETA opportunities, and startups, they determined Gameday was the best fit.

In December 2023, they committed to opening four clinics in Colorado Springs over the next 3–4 years. The transition wasn't just about finding a career—it was about crafting a life that reflected his values, ambitions, and family priorities. Becoming a franchise owner required more than logistical planning; it demanded confidence, conviction, and a willingness to embrace the unknown.

Now, 18 months post-retirement, Andrew and his family are fully settled in Colorado Springs. Alongside his partner Mike, they opened their first Gameday Men's Health clinic in the Broadmoor area in August 2024. Their first year has been dedicated to building a high-performing team, strong company culture, and exceptional patient care. With momentum growing, they are preparing to open a second clinic in the Briargate area within months, proof the investment in transformation was well worth it.

His story is a reminder that when veterans navigate their transition with intention and purpose, they don't just find a career. They build a new legacy.

2025 is poised to be a landmark year for The COMMIT Foundation as we take bold steps to further our mission of empowering those who have served and their families. With the launch of our cutting-edge programs, we will redefine how transitioning veterans, members of the Intelligence and Five Eyes Communities, and their spouses navigate their next chapters. These initiatives will focus on aligning individuals with their sense of purpose and equipping them with actionable insights and skills for impactful careers and meaningful lives. Our commitment to innovation extends to strengthening our partnerships and fostering new collaborations that will create even greater opportunities for our Fellows, alumni, and supporters. As a lifelong support organization, we are doubling down on our promise to provide enduring value by amplifying our thought leadership, publishing transformative insights, and expanding our network of resources.

In 2025, we are not just continuing our work—we are elevating it, ensuring that those we serve thrive in ways that are purposeful, impactful, and deeply connected to the communities around them. This is the year we turn ambition into action, and we couldn't be more excited for what lies ahead.
