2016 Program Updates and Accomplishments

7 WORKSHOPS ACROSS 4 STATES

The COMMIT Foundation facilitated or co-facilitated seven Veteran Mentoring Workshops for servicemembers and Veterans from all branches and various ranks of services. Workshops took place in Montana, California, New York and Texas. Veterans continue to tell us how much these events expand their imagination about what is possible, connect them to outstanding mentors and provide the opportunity to reflect on transition and define next steps.



ONE ON ONE TRANSITION SERVICES EXPAND

Veterans served in **One on One Transition Services** received career counsel focusing on identifying career paths, career progression planning, introductions to mentors or networks, resume assistance, executive coaching and assistance with job acquisition. Many veterans also received scholarships to educational programs or professional development programs.

PROUD PARTNERSHIPS CONTINUE








CORPORATE EDUCATION INITIATIVE
